Ordinance 32-16: Introduced by Edwards: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of part of Lots 3777 and 3779 and all of Lot 3778 located at 304 West Cambridge Street in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Resolution 34-16: Introduced by Council as a Whole: A Resolution declaring the necessity of an election on the question of approving the passage of one quarter percent

(.25%) increase to the existing City of Alliance Income Tax for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the City for a period of five years; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 35-16: Introduced by Dordea: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract for the purpose of purchasing a new sewer camera through the cooperative purchasing programs of the State of Ohio or to advertise for bids and to enter into contracts with other vendors at the lowest and best price, but for a cost not to exceed \$85,000.00 in any case; and declaring an emergency.
