Ordinance 3-17: Introduced by Jakmides: An Ordinance temporarily amending Alliance Codified Ordinance section 182.031 "allocation of funds"; and declaring an emergency.

New Business:

Ordinance 5-17: Introduced by Jakmides: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids for various comprehensive municipal liability insurance coverage and enter into a contract of contracts with the lowest and best bidder for three years with an optional three year extension at the City's sole discretion; and declaring an emergency.

Resolution 6-17: Introduced by Council as a Whole: A Resolution authorizing the Auditor of the City of Alliance, Ohio to establish an Alliance Area Senior Citizens Center Fund, and to establish revenue and expenditure codes; and declaring an emergency.

Resolution 7-17: Introduced by Rhome: A Resolution strongly opposing the State of Ohio Governor's proposed 2017-2018 budget, which proposes centralized collection of Net profit tax returns and other provisions related to the Municipal Income Tax which will cause a substantial loss of revenue needed to support the Health, Safety, Welfare and Economic Development efforts of Ohio Municipalities; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 8-17: Introduced by Jakmides: AN ORDINANCE MAKING PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR 2017 FOR THE GENERAL FUND, WATER FUND, SEWER FUND AND OTHER CITY FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO DRAW PAYMENTS FROM THOSE APPROPRIATIONS UPON RECEIVING PROPER CERTIFICATES AND VOUCHERS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY .
