Ordinance 35-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for services to complete and carry out the 2020 comprehensive road resurfacing and overlay program and the resurfacing of South Arch Avenue from US62/ East State Street to East Broadway Street (2020 Paving) in an amount not to exceed \$850,000; and declaring an emergency.
