

Regular meeting of Council held at Mayors Office
Nov 10th 1879. Members present, Councilmen
J. W. Bard, J. W. Borem, John Watson & H. Linwood
Mayor Martin presiding. The proceedings of last
meeting were read and approved.

The Committee of Street Lights gave a report, in substance
that, they had as yet put up no new lamps, but had
ascertained that a new Gasolene Lamp was in use in
Canton, which was giving satisfaction & that the proprietors
would put up one of the lamps for our inspection & trial
without cost to us provided we did not keep it.

John Watson moved that the committee go on
and get a ^{Gasolene} lamp from Canton & try it & if they think
they are a success to procure 2 of them, & put them
up. Seconded J. W. Borem, vote ayes, Bard
Borem, Linwood & Watson. Carried. —
