and approved - Henry Guinness presented a bill for
one dollar and eighty cents for lighting lamps up to January
14th 1880. John Borem moved to accept the bill, seconded
by E. C. Bard, vote - ayes Messrs E. C. Bard, J W Bard,
J W Watson, John Borem & R McGirr -

J W Bard, J Watson & R McGirr, carried.

The ordinance was read the 3rd time by the clerk and
J W Bard moved it be placed upon its final passage, sec by
Mr Borem, motion carried - all voting in the affirmative.

E. C. Bard moved that the clerk be instructed to publish
the ordinance by written copies according to law sec by Borem
vote ayes Watson - McGirr, J W Borem - J W Bard & E C Bard
on motion of Borem sec by J W Bard, Council adjourned
