

Alliance O. Sept 28th 1896.

City Council met in regular session with president Kay in the Chair and the following members present Crubaugh, Love, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail J. R. Williams. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

On motion of Love seconded by J. R. Williams an allowance of \$12.00 was given J. M. English for Hard Coal during the winter

A report from the Secretary of the Alliance Cemetery Directors was read, asking the City Council to arrange for a vote of the Citizens of Alliance at the regular Fall election on the question of issuing Bonds to the amount of Five Thousand dollars, for the purpose of building a receiving Vault and otherwise improving the Alliance Cemetery

On motion of Love seconded by Scranton the above report was referred to the City Solicitor for investigation.

Mr Harper Brosius called the Councils attention to the dangerous condition of the street near the intersection of Mechanic and Columbia streets.

On motion of Scranton seconded by Scott the above matter was referred to the Street and Sidewalk Committee. On motion Council adjourned.
