

Ohio Edison Holding Community Information Session on October 16th

Ohio Edison is hosting a public meeting to provide the public with details on upcoming environmental remediation work at its property on Front Street, between Franklin and Wood avenues in Alliance.

The property once housed a manufactured gas plant, which was operated in the early 1900s by a predecessor company of Ohio Edison to serve the community's street lighting systems, and home heating and cooking needs before the advent of natural gas. Ohio Edison is working voluntarily to address the site soil impacted by the historical plant's operations, in accordance with the guidance and regulations of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's (OEPA) Voluntary Action Program.
