

Union Avenue Community Garden

Corner of East Cambridge Street and South Union Avenue, Alliance (near Thorne's Market).



The community garden located across the street from Thorne's market in Alliance is tended by the staff from Kridler Garden Nursery. The garden has been operating since 2012; and, was originally established to serve the families that reside in the temporary housing program run by Alliance Children & Families Services.

The ground-level garden takes up a space approximately 45 ft by 80 ft; with plantings in rows on prepared soil and garden ground cloth. A separate water line supplies water to the lot. A variety of produce is planted each season, including tomatoes, peppers, beans, cabbage, cucumbers, lettuces, broccoli, squash, and various herbs.

Produce harvested from the garden is offered at the kitchen meal provided at the Joshua Casteel House on Freedom Street (Catholic Workers Group) as part of their weekly meal service. Extra produce is donated to the Alliance Food Pantry.
