Ordinance No. 046-23: Introduced by: Lohnes: An Ordinance approving the expenses incurred with the Kimble Company for residential garbage and recycling collection for December 2022 and the first quarter of 2023; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 047-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance establishing rates for residential garbage collection for July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 048-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance ratifying a memo of understanding (MOU) between the City of Alliance and the Fraternal Order of Police/Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (F.O.P./O.L.C), for the police clerical bargaining unit; and declaring an emergency.

Resolution No. 051-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: A Resolution congratulating the new president of the University of Mount Union and declaring May 12, 2023 to be "Gregory L. King Day" in the City of Alliance.

Ordinance No. 052-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance providing bonus payments from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds allocated to the City to employees who work for the Alliance Municipal Court; and declaring an emergency.
