Ordinance 71-21: Introduced by Mastroianni: An Ordinance to improve and enhance Part Thirteen – Building Code of the Alliance Codified Ordinances by amending sections 1325.01, 1361 heading, 1361.01, 1361.02, 1361.03, 1365.01, 1369 heading, 1369.01, 1369.02, and deleting chapter 1347.

New Business:

Ordinance 74-21: Introduced by Edwards and Grove: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract with Ohio Cat through Sourcewell, a state of Minnesota service cooperative, for the purchase of a new

wheel loader for the city's distribution department at a cost not to exceed \$179,000.00; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 75-21: Introduced by Mastroianni: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of part lot 1375 and all of lot 1374 located at 407-435 East High Street, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 76-21: Introduced by Mastroianni: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of lots 3417 and 3418 located at 1132 Forest Avenue, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and a State of Ohio.

Ordinance 77-21: Introduced by Grove: An Ordinance making appropriations and transfers of funds in the 2021 Appropriations to provide for necessary expenses and adjustments; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 81-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by Norfolk Southern Railroad; bounded on the South by Prospect Street; bounded on the East by part of lot 482; and bounded on the West by lot 2094 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 82-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by a twenty (20) foot alley; bounded on the South by lot 11829; bounded on the East by part of lot 231; and bounded on the West by lot 221 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 86-20: Introduced by Council as a Whole: An Ordinance declaring the improvement to certain parcels of real property in the City to be a public purpose and exempt from taxation; providing for the collection and deposit of service payments and specifying the purpose for which those service payments may be expended; and authorizing compensation payments to the Marlinton Local School District.
