Ordinance 065-22: Introduced by Mastroianni: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of all of lot 12705 and part of lot 12636 located at 1725 West State street, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio.

Second Readings: None

New Business:

Ordinance 071-22: Introduced by Madison: An Ordinance to enact Section 1501.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Alliance authorizing the Fire Chief to establish fire lanes on public and private property, prohibiting the obstruction of a fire lane or the parking of a vehicle in a fire lane, and providing for the removal of obstructions and the removal and impoundment of parked vehicles; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 072-22: Introduced by Edwards. An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a lease agreement with the Stark County Park District; and declaring an emergency.

Resolution 073-22: Introduced by Council as a Whole: A Resolution authorizing the Auditor of the City of Alliance, Ohio to establish a indigent drivers interlock and alcohol monitoring fund (IDAM fund), and to establish revenue and expenditure codes, and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 82-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by a twenty (20) foot alley; bounded on the South by lot 11829; bounded on the East by part of lot 231; and bounded on the West by lot 221 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 86-21S: Introduced by Council as a Whole: An Ordinance affirming the conditions as set forth in Ordinances 23-20 and 37-20; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 062-22: Introduced by Mastroianni: An Ordinance vacating part of Miller Avenue, bounded on the North and South by Miller Avenue, bounded on the West by lot 6838, part of lot 6837 & part of out lot 290, and bounded on the East by lot 6839, part of lot 6840 & part of out lot 290; accepting and approving the replat of all of lots 6838 & 6839, part of lots 6837 & 6840, part of out lot 290 and a vacated part of Miller Avenue, located at 191 Maplewood Drive, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio.
