Ordinance 001-23: Introduced by Mastroianni: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of lots 12875, 11658, 11659, 11660 and 11661 located at 975 Commonwealth Avenue, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio.

Second Readings:

Ordinance No. 009-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance amending Ordinance 7-91, 161-99, 30-15, and 23-20 Wages, Salaries, and work benefits for employees of the City of Alliance who are not represented by a Collective Bargaining Agreement; and declaring an emergency.

New Business:

Ordinance No. 011-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety and service to negotiate the sale of fire equipment which will no longer be needed for municipal purposes to the Washington Township Fire Department; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 012-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of parts of outlot 233 located at 1410 and 1440 Inwood Road, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and state of Ohio.

Ordinance No. 015-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into contract for the purpose of purchasing a used pick-up truck for the Alliance Municipal Court, at a cost not to exceed \$49,999.00 in any case; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 016-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and to award and enter into contract for the purchase, installation, configuration and licensing of emergency medical dispatch software at a cost not to exceed \$55,000.00; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 017-23: Introduced by: Madison: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into contract for the purchase of software, hardware and implementation services to upgrade the City's dispatch consoles at a cost not to exceed \$73,889.00; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 018-23: Introduced by: Lohnes: An Ordinance making appropriations and transfers of funds in the 2023 Appropriations to provide for necessary expenses and adjustments; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 019-23: Introduced by: Bugara: An Ordinance appropriating funds and authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the South Rockhill paving and partial reconstruction project at a cost not to exceed \$885,000.00; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 020-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance authorizing all actions necessary to accept Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) 2023 Energized Community Grant(s) funds.

Ordinance No. 021-23: Introduced by: Bugara: An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety and Service to negotiate the sale of a used street department snow plow(s) which will no longer be needed for municipal purposes to Smith Township; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 022-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply for a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance for Firefighters grant for the purchase of a NFPA 1901 compliant quint and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 023-23: Introduced by: Council as a Whole: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply for a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance for Firefighters grant for the purpose of funding rescue equipment and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 82-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by a twenty (20) foot alley; bounded on the South by lot 11829; bounded on the East by part of lot 231; and bounded on the West by lot 221 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio.

Ordinance 86-21S: Introduced by Council as a Whole: An Ordinance affirming the conditions as set forth in Ordinances 23-20 and 37-20; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 071-22: Introduced by Madison: An Ordinance to enact Section 1501.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Alliance authorizing the Fire Chief to establish fire lanes on public and private property, prohibiting the obstruction of a fire lane or the parking of a vehicle in a fire lane, and providing for the removal of obstructions and the removal and impoundment of parked vehicles; and declaring an emergency.
