

**MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 17, 2022

Resolution 068-22: Introduced by Lohnes. A Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor. Motion and Second to suspend the rule requiring three readings. Roll Call Vote: Unanimous. Motion and Second to adopt. Roll Call Vote: Unanimous. **ADOPTED.**

Ordinance 069-22: Introduced by King: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract with the Stark County Regional Planning Commission to provide housing rehabilitation technical assistance services to the City of Alliance; and declaring an emergency. Motion and Second to suspend the rule requiring three readings. Roll Call Vote: Unanimous. Motion and Second to adopt. Roll Call Vote: Unanimous. **ADOPTED.**

Ordinance 80-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by Prospect Street; bounded on the South by part of a 13102 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio. **NO FORMAL ACTION.**

Ordinance 81-20: Introduced by Bugara: An Ordinance vacating all of a twenty (20) foot alley bounded on the North by Norfolk Southern Railroad; bounded on the South by Prospect Street; bounded on the East by part of lot 482; and bounded on the West by lot 2094 in the City of Alliance, County of Stark and State of Ohio. **NO FORMAL ACTION.**

Ordinance 059-22: Introduced by Edwards: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and enter into a contract with Fontus Blue Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$41,000.00 through December 31, 2023 for software, installation, and consulting services for the Water Treatment Plant. Motion and Second to bring forward from the table. Roll Call Vote: Unanimous. Motion and Second to Adopt. Roll Call Vote: Unanimous: **ADOPTED.**
