Council met according to adjournment  
Mayor Jones Presiding. Jacob Shaffer

J. B. Milner asked leave to introduce an  
ordinance in relation to keeping Stallions  
& jacks. J. C. Sutton moved that the Rules  
requiring ordinances to be read at three  
separate meetings of the Council be suspended  
which was carried. Then J. B. Milner

moved that the ordinance in reference to  
jacks & Stallions be put upon its final passage  
which was done, the following members voting  
yeas. J. B. Milner, G. Milner, J. C. Sutton  
& Jacob Shaffer. Nays. none.

Ordinance in relation  
to Stallions & jacks.

An Ordinance To Regulate The Keeping  
Of Stallions And jacks.

Sec 1<sup>st</sup> Be it ordained by the Town Council of the  
Published in the Incorporate Village of Alliance, that it shall be  
alliance unlawful for any person or persons to keep  
May 24<sup>th</sup> 1865 any Stallion horse or jack, within the limits of  
said Village to serve mares, with his or their horse  
or jack in any street, alley, lot, or any other place  
exposed to public view within the limits of said  
Village

Sec 2<sup>nd</sup> Every person violating the provisions of the first  
section of this ordinance shall upon conviction  
before the Mayor or other proper officer be fined  
in the sum of five dollars for every offense

Sec 3<sup>d</sup> This ordinance shall be in force from and  
and after its <sup>passage and</sup> publication.
