On Motion a Committee was appointed to confer with persons to be appointed by the fire company in relation to improving fire engine and ascertaining what amount of hose & other necessary fixtures may be needed for the successful working of the same. Mayor Buck, Thomas Buckman and J. Barnaby to compose said Committee, and report as soon as practicable to a meeting of the Council, to be called for that purpose if necessary.

On Motion an order was drawn on the treasury in favor of Mayor Buck for costs in the case of Ohio against Fitzgeralds amount \$4.20

The Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

The citizens on Liberty street presented a petition for a side walk on both sides of said street, from the Noyes House to Broad Street. Thereupon on Motion of Thos Buckman, a side walk was ordered to be put down on both sides of said Liberty street in accordance with the prayer of the Petitioners, and also a walk on the west side of West Street from Alliance Street to Avenue Street, said walks to be six feet in width, of oak or pine lumber 1 1/2 inches thick to be laid crosswise on three stringers 3 by 4 inches and well spiked together, and to be completed in three weeks from the present date.

On Motion Resolved, that the order made at last meeting, setting apart \$600.⁰⁰ dollars due Andrew Summers, on a bond against the Village, be rescinded, and payment of the same deferred for six months.

The following bills were presented and accepted and orders drawn on the treasurer for their amounts respectively, Erno Hoops for repairing side walks over cellar drain at Oswalds property, & near Machine Shop
