On Motion of R. P. Johnson the following resolution was passed by a vote of five ays to one nay

Resolved that the resolution authorising the renting of a room of J. Young Council Chamber only, be amended so as to read Council Chamber and Mayors Office, Mayor Ewan presented his bond which was accepted and approved.

On Motion Adjourned to meet on the 1st Friday evening in May at 7 o'clock

Council Met pursuant to adjournment, Members present J. K. Blackburn, R. P. Johnson, Wm Jones, J. W. Lyman L. B. Davis and J. Barnaby.

Minutes of last Meeting read and approved.

The Cometary Director, Made their Report for the last year showing a Balance in the hands of their Treasurer of \$ 333.88 their report approved and accepted, thereupon Dr W. G. Thomas was duly appointed as a Cometary Director for three years and J. N. Orr, for one year, and ordered to enter into Bonds as required by law which was complied with, The following Amendment was presented to the ordinance regulating public Auctions.

Amendment of sec 2 of an ordinance to regulate public Auctions

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, that section 2nd of an ordinance to regulate Public Auctions be so amended as to read as follows:

That the Mayor or in his absence the Recorder, shall on application issue a licence to any person or persons, to sell any goods or Merchandise, that are not hereinbefore excepted, and charge therefor a sum not less than Five dollars, nor more than twenty five dollars for each ^{day} or part of a day,

On Motion The rule requiring Ordinances to be read at three regular Meetings of the Council before their final passage, was suspended so as to enable the Council to pass the above amendment at this Meeting

The above amendment was then taken up and passed as follows: Yeas R. P. Johnson, L. B. Davis, J. W. Lyman and J. K. Blackburn, 4. Nays None.

On Motion Resolved that Gillespie & East, be required to move their building from the public square previous to our next regular meeting

The Committee appointed to procure furniture for Council Chamber reported that they had procured a set of chairs, stove & pipe and Lamp at a cost of \$19.⁰⁰ report accepted and Committee continued to procure a table,

On Motion an order was drawn on the treasurer in favor of J. W. Lyar to pay for the above mentioned furniture,

On Motion Dr N. G. Thomas, Dr R. P. Johnson and Thomas Buckman, were appointed to constitute a board of health for the present year,

On Motion J. A. Kingsbury, was appointed, to take the names of all persons liable to perform labor on the public highways within the village, and to collect the money from all those who wish to pay rather than work their two days, and give receipts for the same and keep a duplicate of each receipt so given, and pay all moneys so collected into treasury, a table receipts from the treasurer therefor J. W. Lyar who was appointed to ascertain the amount of funds in the treasury, reported that he had examined the accounts of the treasurer and funds in his hands the sum of \$58.²⁸ report accepted and Committee discharged

On Motion J. S. Parker Esq. was duly appointed Solicitor for the present year,

On Motion The Mayor and Recorder were instructed to borrow money sufficient to pay off a Bond held by J. S. Lutes for \$440.⁰⁰ against the village, and execute obligations therefor,

On Motion Orders were drawn on the treasurer for the following sums, H. Buck, services at election \$1.00
E. N. Johnson " 1.00
J. A. Kingsbury " 1.00
Joseph Barnaby " and paper 1.25
Enos Hoopes for street crossings & side walks payable on the 1st day of September next for \$126.10
George Morrison for repairing Lock up 6.00

On Motion J. W. Lyar and Joseph Barnaby were appointed to make an assessment of taxes against the borough for the year, and forward the same to the County Auditor,

On Motion adjourned to meet on the 1st Friday evening June next
