

Alliance Feb 7th 1870

Council Met pursuant to adjournment, Mayor Parker
in the Chair. Members present, C. Steel, H. Altman,
S. Brooke and Barnaby,

Minutes of last Meeting read and approved,

On Motion The Mayor and Recorder were instructed to let a Bond
held by Andrew Summers, against the Village, by executing
a new bond payable in one year from December 7th 1869
interest computed at 13 per cent,

On Motion, The Mayor was ordered to instruct the Marshal not to
interfere with Cows running at large (and not trespassing
previous to the first of April next,

On Motion A Street Crossing was ordered across the street near
Earl's Tannery the location to be designated by H.
Altman,

On Motion A side walk was ordered on the west side of Liberty Street
commencing at the South East corner of the Garwood Farm
and running thence south to the first Alley south of
Summit Street, said walk to be six feet in width and of
good material,

Bill The N. Y. Gas works building Co presented a bill for Gas, and
lighting and keeping in order street lamps up to Jan 1
1870. which was accepted and an order drawn on the
Treasurer for the Amount \$266.²⁵

On Motion S. Brooke was instructed to have the crossing over
the Rail Road on Mt. Union Street repaired so as to be
made safe,

On Motion A side walk was ordered on the north side of Market Street
from Halsers Carriage Shop west to 5th Street, Also a
walk ordered on the North side of Rail Road or Patterson
Street from Freedom Street east as far as the walk
extends, ^(on said street) wherever there is not now a good walk, said
walk to be six feet in width and made of good material

On Motion Adjourned to Meet on 1st Monday in March at 7-1/2

Contract with
N. Gas Works Building Co.

Article of agreement entered into the 4th day of October 1869, by and between the Incorporated Village of Alliance, of the first Part and the New York Gas Works Building Company of the second Part; witnesseth, that the said party of the second part does hereby agree to furnish and erect in good order and ready for use, Ten Iron pillar Lamp Posts, with fixtures & lamps and all necessary attachments to the st. Main of the Alliance Gas Light Company in such places as Messrs Caleb Stebb & J. Sutton, Members of the Council of the Party of the first Part shall direct.

And within sixty days from Sept 30th 1869, and said second Party agrees to fill up all excavations made in laying Pipe for the said Lamps, and be liable for any or all damages that may be sustained during the time of the excavations by reason of said Lamps being erected.

And in consideration thereof, the party of the first part agrees to pay the Party of the second part, the sum of (40) Forty Dollars for each Lamp Post, Lamp service and necessary fixtures & the erecting of the same, and said sum to be paid within 60 days from the 30th day of Sept 1869.

The said Party of the second part does further agree to keep the said Lamps lighted in the same manner & terms that the st. Lamps in the said town are now lighted and to keep the same clean & in good repair for use for the time from the date of this Contract up until the date at which the Contract, for the supply of Gas to the street Lamps, originally made expires, said Original Contract dated 18th Sept 68, and runs 2 years from said date.

And in consideration of the covenants herein provided for the said lighting & keeping the said Lamps in repair, the said Party of the first part does hereby agree to pay to the said Party of the second Part or its representatives the sum of Forty five dollars per year for each Post, in all the sum of \$450. per year, and payable quarterly at the end of each quarter after the said Lamps are lighted.

In testimony whereof the said party of the first part has by the order of Council of said town of Alliance, affixed the corporate seal of said Village and authorized the Mayor to subscribe this agreement in his official capacity, and to be attested by the clerk, and the Party of the second Part has hereto subscribed its name by its duly authorized and empowered President
