The Committee to whom was referred the Petition of J. C.

 Lots No 13 & 14 in Section Sanborn No additions to Alliance being  
 100 feet long from the North line of Oxford Street and also the  
 of the Alley directly west of said part of Park Street. Reported in  
 favor of granting the prayer of the Petitioners

Report of Committee on the above petition of J. C. Sullan & Henrietta  
 Sullan accepted and approved,

Coates, the Street Committee were instructed to have the stream crossing the street near Burgess & Lowers Mill walled from the North end of the Bridge to the line of said Burgess & Lowers property, provided that said Burgess & Lowers make stream straight through their premises, Committee to whom was referred the matter of a new road to the cemetery report in favor of running a road commencing at a point due south of the west line of the fair ground, and running thence north to the road on the North line of section 26, report received and Committee continued to ascertain whether the right of way could be obtained,

On Motion A tree standing in front of Simon Johnsons property on Mt. Union street on sidewalk was ordered to be removed;

A. W. Coates offered the following resolution which was passed Resolved that a sidewalk be laid from Grains & Steels Banking House to the Stone Culvert on the south side of Alliance street, according to the Ordinance where a new walk is necessary,

On Motion Saml. Brooke was instructed to grade the sidewalk from the west side of S. W. Ramsays lot on West Alliance street east not to exceed 150 yards at 15 cents per yard

Resolved that the Clerk is instructed to inform the Town printer that if either of them will have a report to attend the meetings of the Council and take and publish the proceedings, he shall have all the printing done by the Council, and in case they both take and publish the proceedings the printing shall be divided between them

On Motion the Street Committee were instructed to have the rapping on South side of Main street finished to Stone Culvert, adjourned to meet Dec 5th at 7 o'clock
