

Council Chamber, Alliance O June 3 1889

Council met in regular session
Vice President Hull in the chair and the
following members present. Betts Bush
Sept Miller Hull. Hartzell Brinker
Craime Crubaugh. Minutes of preceding
meeting read and approved.

A Communication from A Lamott
of the Board of Health in regard to
nuisances in different parts of the city
was read and on motion referred to
Committee on Streets and Alleys

An Ordinance, entitled an
Ordinance Providing for and fixing the
rate of taxation and the distribution
of the same for the year 1889 was read
and on motion of Bush seconded by
Miller the same was placed on its final
Passage. The yeas and nays being called
resulted. Yeas 8. Nays none.

Messrs Nicholson & Co. asked that they
be paid the second installment on
the Arch Street Paving Contract.

The city engineer submitted the following
report. To the Council of the city of
Alliance Ohio. I would report that
by estimate one half of the work of Paving
Arch Street has been done at this date

on motion of Betts seconded by Bush
The report was accepted and ^{ordered} placed
on file. Moved by Bush. Seconded by
Hartzell that an order for \$700.00 be
drawn to pay second installment on Arch
Street Paving. Motion prevailed.

The Mayor's report of fines and licenses
collected for the month of May was read
and on motion of Betts the same was
accepted. Bills for the month of May was
then read, and on motion of Betts Sec
by Brinker the finance committee was
instructed to have ordinance prepared

President Pennock at this time entered the room and occupied the chair

for the payment of the same

All ordinance entitled "an ordinance to appropriate money in the treasury to pay the second installment due on the arch street paving contract" was then read.

Bush moved the passage of the ordinance seconded by Hartzell. The yeas and nays being called resulted Yeas 9 nays none. Pres Pennock declared the ordinance passed.

An ordinance entitled "An ordinance to assess a special tax on the real estate bounding and abutting on Arch Street from Summit Street South to State Street and to issue bonds in anticipation of the collection of such assessments" was read. Moved by Betts seconded by Brinker the rules be suspended and the ordinance read second time by its title.

The yeas and nays being called resulted Yeas. Betts. Bush. Miller. Hull. Brinker. Coraine. Lombayh. Pennock. Nays. Hartzell Yeas (8) Nays (1). Motion declared lost.

The engineer then read report of committee on Liberty Street improvement. and on motion of Betts seconded by Hull the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Coraine moved that the report be adopted and the clerk be instructed to advertize for bids according to the plans and specifications. The yeas and nays called resulted. Yeas. 9 nays. none. Motion declared carried.

Plans and specifications for the improvement of Union Avenue was read and on motion of Brinker seconded by Hartzell the same were adapted. Betts moved that the committee on printing be instructed to have plans and specifications for improvement of Liberty Street and Union Ave. printed Yeas & Nays called. resulted. Yeas 7. nays 0. Motion declared carried.

On motion of Brinker. Jno Atwell and E.H Brosius were appointed to act with engineer

Moved by Brinker that the culvert
 on South Arch Street be extended west
 to accommodate the grading now being
 done. and that City Engineer and
 H. B. Crubank have charge of the same
 Secanded. Betts and carried.

Moved by Burt and seconded by
 Brinker that when we adjourn it be
 until Monday evening June 10. Carried
 no further business. Council adjourned
