

Alliance Ohio July 27<sup>th</sup> 1891

Council met in special session upon the following call of the Mayor  
 "You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet on Monday evening July 27<sup>th</sup> 1891 for the purpose of taking action on the report of the <sup>Sewer</sup> Committee on the second Ward Sewer, to consider the report of the Judiciary Committee on the purchase of a city map, and for the reading of Ordinances to improve South Liberty Street, Linden Avenue and Patterson Street,"

with Vice President Bush in the Chair and the following members present. Brinker Cowan. ~~Cordobaugh~~ Drove Jenkins Kaylor Love. Absent Earley Kiplinger Kynett. Wilson arriving after roll call.

The Sewerage Committee to whom had been referred the North Liberty Street Sewer, reported in favor of changing the course of the present sewer and starting at a point near Robert Wilson's connecting with the sewer running through under the Railroad. Thence across Patterson Street thence diagonally across the lots now owned by James Scott to the street running parallel with the C & P R. R. and thence along said street to the stream running west of the pattery, using 2 1/2 inch tile for a distance of          feet and the balance of the distance with an open ditch.

Brinker moved that the Sewer Committee be instructed to have the sewer put in in accordance with the above report. Seconded by Jenkins and Carried Yeas 9 nays 0.

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Drove the Sewer Committee was instructed to have the tile taken out of the present sewer on North Liberty Street and taken care of.

a map of the city reported as having consulted with Mr Paul in regard to the same, and he being present made a proposition to furnish the city with three complete maps of the city, mounted and hung on rollers, all to be first class for the sum of four hundred dollars. \$400<sup>00</sup>.

On motion of Devine the proposition was referred to the Judiciary Committee. Engineer and Chairman of the Finance Committee. The above committee after consulting with Mr Paul made the following report:

Your Committee to whom was referred the matter of a city map would respectfully report that we recommend that the proposition as made by Mr Paul in writing (and as changed) be accepted. He to make one map mounted on rollers and two bound in book form divided into wards.

Cost of binding in excess of the cost of mounting on rollers to be paid by the city."

The proposition of Mr Paul as changed to conform to the report was then presented providing for the making of one map hung on rollers & two bound in book form, divided by wards. The same to be completed in ninety days, for the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400<sup>00</sup>) one half to be paid November 1<sup>st</sup> 1891 and one half Feb 15<sup>th</sup> 1892.
