

Alliance Ohio October 5th 1891.

Council met in regular session with president Wilson in the chair and the following members present Brinker Bush Leowan Cornbough Devine Janbins Kayler Kephlinger Kynett Lovel. Absent Early. Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Mayor's report
The Mayor's report for the month of September reporting fines and licenses collected to the amount of \$65⁰⁰ was read and an motion of Brinker the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Report of Cemetery Trustees
The report of the trustees of the cemetery was read and on motion of Devine accepted and ordered placed on file.

Petition for Water on Arch
A Petition from residents of South Arch street requesting that Water Mains be laid on said street before the same is improved. was read and referred to the Water Committee.

Reading of Bills
and passage of Claims Ordinances
A number of bills against the city having been approved by the finance committee were read and an ordinance ordered prepared providing for their payment.

The same being prepared was read and Brinker moved the final passage of the same seconded by Kayler and Carried yeas 11 nays 0.

Appointment Committee in Pearsall case
On Motion of Brinker seconded by Devine the Messrs Bush and Cornbough were appointed as a committee to look after the City's interest in the case of the City against C. F. Pearsall.

Contract with Water Wks Co extended
On Motion of Brinker seconded by Cornbough the contract with the Alliance Water Wks Co which expires Oct. 13/1891 was extended until Nov 1st 1891 and the water committee instructed to report to council a plan for taking water to the sixth ward.

An Ordinance to assess a special tax on the real estate bounding on Linden Avenue from Main Street south to Broadway and to issue bonds in anticipation of the collection of such assessments. was read first time and on motion of Lane seconded by Bush; Yeas 10 - nays 1 (Kynett) the rules were suspended and the ordinance read second time by title.

Brinker moved the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time and be placed on its final passage. seconded by Keyler and carried. yeas Brinker Bush Cowan Lambangh Devine Jenkins Keyler Keplinger ~~Keyler~~ Lane Wilson. Nays Kynett. Yeas 10 nays 1

to protect the railroad property from
parties throwing refuse or filth on the same.
