

Alliance Ohio March 27th 1894

Council met in Special Session upon call of the Mayor for the purpose of taking action on the Street sweeping Contract. The Workhouse Contract. and to consider North arch Street

Patterson Street. and Hester Avenue Grades
President Wilson presiding and the following members present: Buck Bush Conyer Cowan Davidson Harris Love Williams Wilson absent. Crubangh. Gable. Defert.

A contract for removing the dirt from the paved streets of the city was presented as follows:

This agreement made and entered into between the City of Alliance and Obadiah Shidler Contractor witnesseth: That the said Contractor is to have the privilege of cleaning the paved streets of the City by private subscription from the owners or residents of the abutting property where the funds so raised together with the amount to be paid by the City for removing the dirt as hereinafter specified will in his judgment be sufficient to pay for the work. The Contractor agrees to sweep the resident paved streets after six o'clock P.M. and Main Street ^{and the square} after nine o'clock P.M. twice each week or as often as may be necessary to keep them clean and free from mud and dust and is also to remove the dirt from Catch-basins and under gutter bridges on such streets as he sweeps. The City hereby agrees to pay the Contractor the sum of Twenty five cents (25c) per cubic yard for loading and removing all dirt and accumulations from the Streets swept as above specified. The Contractor to have the disposal of the sweepings. No payments to be made except on itemized bills approved by the Street Committee of Council showing the dates number of cubic yards and streets from which the dirt was removed. Nothing in this Contract shall be so construed as to require the Contractor to sweep on any Street or part of a Street

where the private subscription will not in his opinion justify him in ~~so~~ doing but all dirt swept up must be removed at the price above specified

This contract to begin April 1st 1894 and to continue for one year but should the contractor fail or neglect to perform his part of this agreement the council may for that cause cancel this contract by giving the contractor fifteen days notice to that effect"

Bush moved that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the above contract on behalf of the City, seconded by Conger and carried

A form of contract with the Stark County workhouse for the boarding of prisoners having been sent to council was on motion of Bush referred to the Judiciary Committee to report at next meeting

Yeas 9 nays none The rules were declared suspended and the ordinance was read second time by title

An Ordinance to amend the grade on Hester Avenue was read first time and Conger moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by
