

Alliance Ohio September 9th 1896

Special meeting

A. Special session of the Alliance City Council was called in the City Hall Wednesday eve Sept 9th 1896 at the usual hour.

This meeting was called for the purpose of passing an Ordinance for the payment of Claims.

Signed B. F. Truscott, Mayor.

President Kay presided with the following members present Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Sefert, Trail, J. G. Williams.

On Motion of Conger the reading of the minutes of the preceding meeting was dispensed with.

Payment of Bills

Love of the Finance Committee reported that a number of Bills against the City had been approved and asked that they be read, the Bills were read, and Love called the Council's attention to the fact of there not being sufficient money in the General and Sewer Disposal funds to pay the claims and moved that there be transferred from the unapportioned fund to the General fund \$195.75 and to the Sewer Disposal fund \$152.05 seconded by Conger and carried.

Love moved that an Ordinance for the payment of the Claims be prepared see by Trail and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved it be placed on its final passage seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Sefert, Trail, J. G. Williams, Kay yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Clerk to notify
St Railway Co.

On motion of Trail seconded by Love the Clerk was instructed to notify the Officers of the Street Railway Co that if they did not intend to replace the stones that they were taking out of Main Street to put the same on the City Lot at the corner of Columbus and Mechanic Streets

On motion of Trail Council adjourned.
