

Alliance Ohio September 21st, 1898.

The Alliance City Council met in special session upon the following call:

A special meeting will be held in the City Hall Wednesday evening Sept 21st, 1898 at 7 o'clock to consider granting the use of certain streets and alleys to Yellow Cross Co No 83 Uniform Rank Knights of Pythias, for the purpose of holding a Street fair and Carnival.

President Morgan being absent the meeting was called to order by president Protem Conger with the following members present Gable, King, Katzenstein, Love, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman. absent Morgan & Gilson.

On motion of King seconded by Miller the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

P. W. Nelson and A. L. McDonald representing the Uniform Rank Knights of Pythias were present, and asked the City Council to grant them the use of Market street from Arch Avenue to Freedom Avenue and Freedom Avenue from Market Street to Columbia street, also the City Lot and a portion of the Public Square for the purpose of holding a Street fair and Carnival.

Scott moved that the Uniform Rank Knights of Pythias be granted the use of the Public Streets and grounds asked for seconded by Katzenstein.

Wilson offered the following amendment to the above motion and moved its adoption, that all permits for holding entertainments and attractions of different kinds in the City during the time of the Carnival be issued by the Order holding the Carnival, and each permit issued to be approved by the Mayor of the City, seconded by Love and carried.

The Original motion as amended was then voted upon and was unanimously adopted.

On motion of Scott seconded by King Council adjourned.
