

Alliance Ohio April 19th 1899.

Special Call.

The Alliance City Council met in special session upon the following call:

You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio will be held in the City Hall, of the said City on Wednesday evening April 19th 1899 at 7:30 O'clock. This meeting is called for the purpose of transacting the following business to wit: - To pass an Ordinance to issue Bonds in the matter of the improvement of South Union Avenue; to pass an Ordinance to issue Bonds in the matter of the improvement of North Union Avenue; to pass an Ordinance to issue Bonds in the matter of the improvement of South Freedom Avenue; to adopt a Resolution for the construction of Lateral Sanitary sewers Nos 13, 15, 30 & 31; to provide for securing bids of Contractors and for the sale of Bonds to improve South Union Avenue; North Union Avenue and South Freedom Avenue.

The meeting was called to order by President Morgan and the following members being present, Gable, Katzenstein, Low, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman. Absent Gilson, present 11, absent 1.

On motion of Gable seconded by Wilson the reading of the minutes of the preceding meeting was dispensed with.

H. Morgan, yeas 10 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time, Gable moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Katgenstein, Lovv, McDonald, Scott, Scranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. A. Resolution to improve certain Streets, Avenues,
and alleys by constructing Lateral Sewers Nos 13, 15, 30 and
31 was read as follows:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio,
that it is hereby declared necessary that the present
sanitary sewer system be extended by excavating and laying
sewer pipes and building manholes and flush tanks according
to plans, profiles and specifications relating to the same
now on file in the office of the City civil Engineer, along
the following described streets, Avenues and alleys:

Lateral Sanitary sewer No. 13 - Commencing at a manhole
on Lateral sewer No. 30, in Mechanic Avenue at the first Alley
south of Market street; thence south along the west side of
Mechanic Avenue to the first alley south of and parallel to
Columbia Street; thence west along the first alley south of
and parallel to Columbia street, to the first Alley west of
and parallel to Mechanic Avenue; thence south along the first
alley west of and parallel to Mechanic Avenue to the first
alley south of and parallel to Broadway; thence west along
the first Alley south of and parallel to Broadway to the center
of Park Avenue; thence south along the center of Park Avenue
to the center of Oxford street; thence west along the center
of Oxford street to the alley east of Union Avenue.

Lateral Sanitary Sewer No. 15 - Commencing at a manhole
on Lateral Sewer No. 13, in Park Avenue, at the intersection of
High street; thence west along the center of High street to
the first Alley east of Union Avenue.

Lateral Sanitary Sewer No. 30, Commencing at a manhole
on Lateral sewer No. 17, in Mechanic Avenue, at the intersection
of the first alley south of and parallel to Market street;
thence west along the first alley south of and parallel to
Market street, to the first Alley east of Union Avenue.

Lateral Sanitary Sewer No. 31 - Commencing at a manhole
on Lateral sewer No. 13, in the first Alley south of and
parallel to Columbia street, at the first Alley ^{east} of Park Avenue;
thence west along the first alley south of and parallel to
Columbia street, to the first alley east of Union Avenue.

The cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed
per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting on said

improvement, according to the laws and Ordinances on the subject of assessments and shall be payable in three annual installments, and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

The Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the corporation.

Gable moved that the foregoing resolution be adopted seconded by Wilson, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Katgenstein, Lorr, McDonald, Scott, Scranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan, yeas 10 nays none, and the Resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Scott the Clerk was instructed to advertise for Bids for the improvement of South Union Avenue; North Union Avenue and South Freedom Avenue.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Gable the Clerk was instructed to advertise for the Sale of Bonds for the improvement of South Union Avenue; North Union Avenue and South Freedom Avenue.

Scott moved that the City Engineer be authorized to have his specifications for the different Street improvements printed seconded by Gable and Carried.

On motion of Scott seconded by Williams Council adjourned.
