

Council Chamber June 27-1881.

Adjourned Meeting.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor at 8 o'clock. Members of council who were present were - J. G. Earnst, J. L. Shunk, Jos. Preston, David Hasler & W. P. Rice.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read, approved, and adopted.
