

Clark moved the Side walk Committee hear the complaints when made by persons desiring to alter buildings sidewalk that are ordered new, and report to the council. See by Schooley and carried.

Clark moved the clerk be instructed to make out a bill and present to the Administrator of the estate of John M Johnson deceased, for the cost of constructing the side walk in front of lot No. 60 on main street, bill amounting to \$23.62 for $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet at 75¢ per foot, and if bill is not paid, to forward to the auditor as a levy against the property. Seconded by Miller, vote ayes, Schooley, Miller, Grant & Clark. -

The Mayor presented a request from Mrs J M Johnson, for privilege to take dirt from the street east of her premises on main street, to fill a low place in her lot.

Mr Clark moved the street Committee be authorized to use their discretion or judgement in regard to allowing her to remove the dirt, for filling lot, and as to amount taken if allowed. Motion seconded by Schooley, vote ayes, Schooley, Miller, Grant and Clark.

The Mayor made the appointment of Joseph Preston and Will. Grubough as members of the Board of Health. Moved by that the appointment be confirmed, see by Miller and carried. On motion of Grant, seconded by Clark, Council adjourned.
