

Alliance Given February 21<sup>st</sup> 1898.  
 City Council met in regular session in the City Hall, President Morgan and Vice President Conger being absent, Kay moved that G. G. King act as president pro tem, seconded by Williams and carried.

The Roll was called with the following members present Kay, King, Love, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams.

On motion of Kay seconded by Scott the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

A Resolution declaring it necessary to improve Main Street from Arch Avenue to the Cleveland & Pittsburgh Railroad was read.

Scott moved that the above mentioned resolution be adopted seconded by Kay the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Love, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams yeas 7 nays none.

On motion of Kay seconded Scranton the motion to adopt the above mentioned resolution was reconsidered on account of requiring a two thirds vote of the Council elected to pass the resolution.

Kay moved that when this Council adjourns it be to meet Wednesday evening Feb 23<sup>rd</sup> at seven O'clock, seconded by Williams and carried.

On motion of Scranton seconded by Trail Council adjourned.
