## **Recreational Fire Permit Information.**

If you wish to have a recreational fire at your residence or location, you must first call the Alliance Fire Department to initiate the permit process. An inspector will come to survey the area to ensure that you meet the criteria below. The cost for a (1) weekend permit is \$15. A seasonal permit is \$100. To inquire further, please call (330) 821-1213 weekdays between the hours of 8am and 4 pm. Cash or check only. Checks should be made out to the Alliance Fire Department.

A recreational fire may be conducted in a pit or container not less than twenty-five (25) feet from any road, structure or property line as per Ohio Fire Code rule 1301:7-7-03 and section 1511.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Alliance. Attention shall be given to wind direction and velocity. A portable fire extinguisher or hose with adequate water supply shall be readily available. Flammable liquids shall not be used to kindle the fire. No forms of trash or yard debris shall be burned at any time. Only seasoned, dry firewood may be burned. The fire shall be attended by an adult at all times and be extinguished by 11PM on the expiration date of the permit.

Another option is to utilize a UL listed and identified prefabricated fire pit with spark arrestor screens in place. These units are available from places such as Lowes. If using one of these units, all of the precautions listed above must be followed, but a permit fee is not required.
