Aultman Alliance Community Hospital provides round trip transportation to patients who do not have access to/from medical appointments, as long as both the patient and physician are located within the city limits. Advance notice must be given, at least 24hrs, prior to time of appointment. Patients must be self sufficient or have an aide. Family members must accompany patients under the age of 16.

Managed Care Organizations



Aetna will provide non-emergency transportation for members traveling 30 miles or more from their home to receive covered health care services. Member Services are available 24/7. For more information, call 1-855-364-0974.

AmeriHealth members can get unlimited non-emergency trips for provider visits more than 30 miles from their home. Qualifying members can get up to 60 on-emergency one-way trips per year within 30 miles of their home, including unlimited additional trips for chemotherapy, radiation, dialysis, pre-natal and postpartum appointment and for medical services for members who use a wheelchair. Anthem members are eligible for non-emergency transportation through their Access2Care program. Toll-free reservation line is available 24/7. To schedule a ride, call 800-282-9720.



Buckeye members are eligible for non-emergency transportation (15 round trips/30 one way trips per 12 month period, per member) to covered healthcare, dental, WIC, and CDJFS appointments. For more information members may call 1-866-246-4358.



CareSource members are eligible for transportation to/from the health partner's office (15 round trips/30 one way trips per year, per member) for trips less than 30 miles. For more information members may call 1-800-488-0134.



Humana members are eligible for 30 one-way (15 round) trips each calendar year, no approvals needed. Unlimited transportation is available for limited services. For more information, please call 855-739-5986.



Molina members are eligible for non-emergency transportation (24 one-way trips each calendar year, per member) to health care appointments. For more information members may call 1-844-491-4761.



UnitedHealthcare members are eligible for transportation (15 round trips/30 one way trips per year, per member) to medical visits or the pharmacy. For more information members may call 1-800-895-2017.

Fixed Route - services are provided along predetermined routes and times

Curb-to-Curb (Proline) - shared-ride, origin-to-destination for individuals whose disabilities present them from independently utilizing SARTA's fixed routes (Proline ADA Paratransit & Proline PLUS).

Proline rides must be scheduled in advance and are provided on specially equipped smaller buses and vehicles operated by trained SARTA personnel.

Travel Training Classes - SARTA provides a 45 minute class to teach individuals how to effectively utilize services. If interested in the class, call (855) 887-2782.
