

# Community Garden at Feed My Sheep Ministries

*114 East Main Street (parking lot at Feed My Sheep Ministries), Downtown Alliance.*



The garden at Feed My Sheep Ministries in downtown Alliance was constructed as part of a community volunteer project by students from the University of Mount Union in the spring of 2012.

The garden consists of three raised beds on asphalt. The beds were constructed using a sand and gravel base layer, topped by soil and fertilizer. The frames consist of two levels of masonry block.

Each garden bed is approximately 11 ft by 5 ft; and, water is supplied by a spigot located at the church. A variety of produce is planted each season, including tomatoes, peppers, cabbage, cucumbers, eggplant, and zucchini.

Produce harvested from the garden is used for the meal service provided each Thursday at Feed My Sheep Ministries' kitchen, or is donated to local families.
